







Presingoll Farm Caravan & Camping Site is a beautiful site


overlooking the dramatic North Cornwall Coast, close to the charming village of St. Agnes, yet surrounded by rolling countryside. The site covers

On-site facilities


- Small shop offering milk, eggs and newspapers delivered daily.

St Agnes & surrounding areas

St. Agnes is a thriving village with plenty of shops, restaurants, pubs and a local museum.

The lovely sandy beaches of Trevaunance Cove and Chapel Porth are 1.5 miles from Presingoll Farm and the renowned surfing beaches of Porthtowan and Newquay are just a short drive away.



St. Agnes offers a variety of coastal, inland and valley walks, highlighting a huge range of interests from bird watching and wildlife to geology, folklore and local history.

Horseriding can be arranged with local riding stables giving children the opportunity to experience riding for the first time or for those more experienced a trot or gallop in the countryside.

There is plenty of great biking available with easy access to many trails and cycle paths suitable for the family or keen mountain biker.
